### DATUK SERI UTAMA DR. RAIS YATIM

Datuk Seri Utama Dr. Rais Yatim is the current Malaysian Information, Communications and Culture Minister. He was former Minister of Foreign Affairs and has actively campaigned for the criminalising of war. He is a lawyer by training.



### DATO' AHMAD TALIB

Dato' Ahmad Talib is the Executive Director, News for Media Prima. He started his career in 1972 and has also served at Bernama, Business Times and Berita Harian. A popular blogger, he is currently a Trustee in Yayasan Salam.



### DENIS J. HALLIDAY

Denis J. Halliday, graduated from Trinity College, Ireland and holds an M.A. in Economics, Geography and Public Administration. He was appointed by then to the post of United Nations Humanitarian Coordinator in Iraq in 1997 but resigned in 1998 in protest of the economic sanctions imposed on Iraq.



### LEUREN MORET

Leuren Moret is an expert on radiation and public health issues. She is on the Organising Committee of the World Committee on Radiation Risk, an organisation of independent radiation specialists. Lauren was a whistleblower in the Livermore National Laboratory where she worked for more than 5 years. She is also an Environmental Commissioner for the City of Berkeley.



### TAN SRI SANUSI JUNID

Tan Sri Sanusi Junid is the former Chief Minister of Kedah Darul Aman. An extensive reader, he also served as President of the International Islamic University (IIUM) from 2000 until 2008.



### MUHAMMAD UMAR

Muhammad Umar is Chairman of the Ramadhan Foundation based in London and became the youngest person ever to be invited on the BBC Hard Talk to discuss the aftermath of 7th July terrorist attacks in London. He has appeared on numerous TV and radio interviews and has delivered numerous lectures throughout the UK, Europe and USA.



### DR. SOUAD N. AL-AZZAWI

Dr. Souad N. Al-Azzawi is a former Vice President of Mamoun University of Scientific Affairs, former Professor of Environmental Engineering at Baghdad University and a recipient of the 2003 Nuclear-Free Future Award for her work on environmental contamination after the Gulf War in Iraq. She has published 50 papers on Hazardous Waste Management and Radiological Pollution from the use of Depleted Uranium Weapons in Iraq.



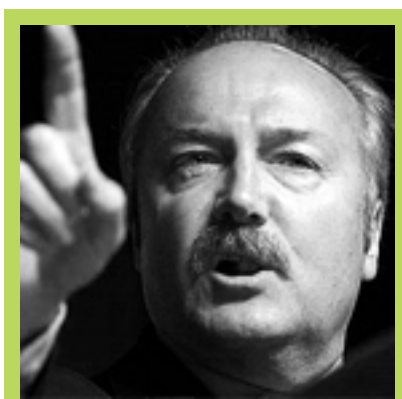
### HANS VON SPONECK

Hans von Sponeck served as a UN Assistant Secretary-General and UN Humanitarian Coordinator for Iraq. He was responsible for directing all UN operations in the country, managing distribution of goods under the "Oil for Food" Programme and verifying Iraqi compliance with that programme. He resigned in February 2000 in protest of unjust international policies towards Iraq.



### DATO' MUKHRIZ MAHATHIR

Dato' Mukhriz Mahathir is Deputy Minister of International Trade and Industry. He is also Advisor to Perdana Peace Global Organisation and former Coordinator of Peace Malaysia.



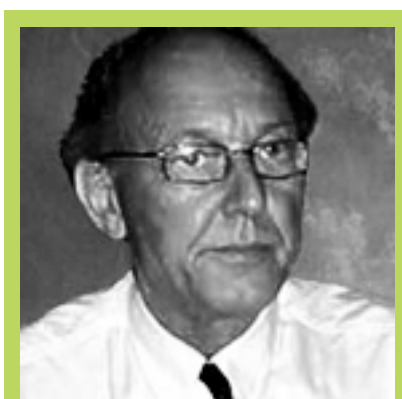
### GEORGE GALLOWAY

George Galloway is a British politician, author and broadcaster. He is well known for his vigorous campaigns championing the rights of the Palestinian people. Actively involved in politics, he attempted to overturn the economic sanctions imposed on Iraq in the 1990s and early 2000s. In parliament he also tried to avert Britain's participation in the 2003 invasion of Iraq.



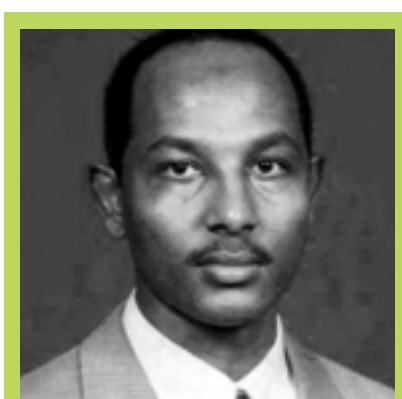
### CYNTHIA MCKINNEY

Cynthia McKinney is a former U.S. Presidential Candidate and a member of the Green Party. McKinney has traveled all over the world as a proponent of peace. Throughout 2003 and 2004, McKinney toured the U.S. and much of Europe campaigning against the Iraq War and the Bush administration.



### MICHEL CHOSSUDOVSKY

Michel Chossudovsky is Professor of Economics at the University of Ottawa. He was also visiting professor in various academic institutions in Western Europe, Latin America and Southeast Asia. Chossudovsky has acted as economic adviser to governments of developing nations. He is also Editor for the Centre for Research on Globalisation.



### SAMI AL' HAJJ

Sami Al' Hajj is a Sudanese journalist for the Al Jazeera network. In 2001, he was arrested while on the job and was detained as 'enemy combatant' at the Guantanamo Bay. He was the only journalist to be held in Guantanamo and was only released in 2008, without ever being charged.

### HANA BAYATI

Hana Bayati is an Executive Committee Member of the Brussels Tribunal. She is also a freelance documentary film maker and a peace activist.

### GAJENDRA SINGH

Gajendra Singh served as Counselor at the Indian Embassy in Paris between 1973 and 1975. He later served as India's Ambassador to Jordan, Romania and Senegal. From August 1992 to April 1996, Gajendra served his country as Ambassador to Turkey and Azerbaijan.

### DIRK ADRIAENSSENS

Dirk Adriaenssens is an Executive Committee Member of Brussels Tribunal and a renowned peace activist. He is also the Coordinator of SOS Iraq.

### GENERAL DATO' SERI MOHD AZUMI

General Dato' Seri Mohd Azumi was former Chief of Army in the Malaysian Armed Forces. He retired in 2004 after serving for more than 37 years. He also served as the Senior Military Intelligence Officer in the United Nations Military Observer Mission in Iraq and Kuwait. He is currently Executive Director of Perdana Global Peace Organisation.

### KHUDHAIR WAHEED HUSSEIN

Khudhair Waheed Hussein is a Medical Doctor and Assistant Professor of Hematology who worked in the University of Baghdad during the American invasion of Iraq. He is an experienced medical officer and has contributed widely to medical journals as well as other publications. He is member of the Iraqi Pathologist Society and currently lectures at the University of Syria.
